Hope on the Horizon in Andhra Pradesh

An estimated 2.4 million people are living with HIV in India. In Andhra Pradesh, the prevalence of this disease is nearly five times higher than in other regions of Southern India. A few short weeks ago, as the sun set, hundreds gathered as Harvest India dedicated the first HIV/AIDS Hospice in the region. After months of construction, electrical, and gas line work, the finishing touches were completed and the final inspection list was checked rigorously... we were ready to welcome our first patients. Trusting the financial support to fund the Hope Center to the Lord's hands, we have faithfully pressed forward in God's calling and opened its doors to twelve patients in Cherukupalli. The vision for the project is to invite those affected by this debilitating disease into a community of people who have set their eyes on heavenly treasure. We believe that as we administer care and medicine to those affected with HIV/AIDS, God will begin conversations with His children. As we help foster journeys that reinstate personal relationships to the Creator, He will reconcile these men and women to Himself.



A Day in New Found Hope

Patients wake between 7am and 8am and begin their day with a bath and breakfast. For most, the opportunity to sleep and bathe in a protected, welcoming environment has become foreign due to the extreme poverty, oppression and neglect experienced by those who contract HIV in India. We provide three hot meals, each day, and encourage those in our community to engage in light exercise. Morning devotion unfolds as our staff encourages them to spend time in the Word and in prayer as they introduce the Gospel and explain God's unfailing love. It's the first of three opportunities each and every day when our staff encourages and fosters conversations with God through prayer and devotion. The afternoons allow time for our doctors and nursing staff to render medical care and individually evaluate and

treat each man and woman. Every few days a pastor visits the center to teach from the Word and prays healing over each individual in our care. After gathering in community for dinner and evening devotion, the men and women turn in for the night. Please join us as we pray for each of the unwritten endings to the stories of these men and women as God unfolds His perfect plan of restoration, hope, dignity, and new life.

Project Costs:

- Individual Patients Care: \$100/month including housing, food and medication
- Current Housing Cost: \$1,200/month (presently housing 12 patients)
- Potential Capacity: 20 total patients increasing monthly cost to \$2,000/per month
- Additional Monthly Expenses: \$1,000/month (includes staff, land taxes, utilities and building maintenance)
- Volunteers: 2 Nurses, full time ~ 5 Doctors, on rotation
- Projected Total Cost: \$3000/month when fully occupied

Breaking Bread at the Hope Center ~ What's on the Menu?

- Breakfast: Chapati, Outma, or Pudi, Milk, Egg, Banana
- Lunch: Mixed Vegetables, Curry, Rice
- Dinner: Multi-Grain Chapati (good for increased health and vitality), Curry, and a blended protein drink called "Ragimalt" (contains protein and essential nutrients)
